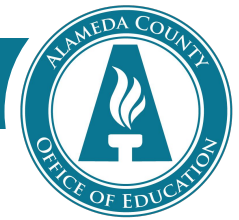


DACA / ICE INFORMATION FOR DISTRICTS AND SCHOOLS

DISTRICT, SCHOOL EMPLOYEE, AND LEADER FACT SHEET



You may have heard the recent news reports that Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) could be planning to conduct major “sweeps” targeting individuals and workplaces in the Bay Area. This news, along with the continued uncertainty surrounding DACA protections for childhood arrivals, and the withdrawal of temporary protected status for immigrants from El Salvador, has left many families in our community feeling vulnerable and afraid.

Let's meet these reports with the calm strength of being prepared and informed. Here are some recommended actions for your district to take and resources to share.

- Review existing district sanctuary/safe place/safe haven resolutions with your staff
 - PROVIDE COPY OF CURRENT RESOLUTIONS IF APPLICABLE
- Determine a protocol for alerting school/district leadership of any ICE activity impacting students/families
- Determine protocol for response to an ICE activity on a school campus in (potential) violation of School District policy.
- Assure staff that you do not expect ICE enforcement to be targeting schools or district workplaces. However, if that does occur, please ask staff to respond using an established protocol. For example, your Site Administrator will respond to the agent(s) and immediately notify Student Services and the Superintendent's Office.
