

## Summary of Fare Changes

*This table summarizes only fare policies that are changing January 1, 2019.*

TRANSFERS	NEW 1/1/19
Transfers	No paper transfers. Use Clipper® or Day Pass.
Between Wheels/Rapid Routes - Clipper®	One free transfer within 120 minutes from time of first fare payment with Clipper®.
Transfers to/from County Connection, WestCat, or Tri Delta Transit	No paper transfers. Single transfer credit within 120 minutes from time of first fare payment with Clipper®.
Transfers from BART	No paper transfers. Use Clipper Card for transfer credit from BART.
DAY PASSES	NEW 1/1/19
Day Pass - Adult Now only on Clipper®	\$3.75 - Available on buses at the farebox.
Day Pass - Senior/Disabled Now only on Clipper® and RTC	\$1.75 - Available on buses at the farebox.
FARE BUSTER and SENIOR/DISABLED 10-RIDE	NEW 1/1/19
Farebuster 10-ride Tickets and Senior/Disabled 10-ride Tickets	No longer sold, but existing tickets are valid until 12/31/19.
For Transfers and Multiple Trips (until 12/31/19)	Give the driver 2 tickets for 1 new Day Pass.

Youth Fare with Clipper®	\$1.60 for youth 18 and under. Not available with cash. Get free Youth Clipper Card at Wheels Office, Livermore Transit Center, or at <a href="http://clippercard.com">clippercard.com</a> .

## EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2019 Fare Policy Changes

Effective January 1, 2019, the Livermore Amador Valley Transit Authority (LAVTA) will be implementing a number of fare policy changes.

These changes are outlined within.

## Day Passes



Day Passes offer unlimited rides during a single day. LAVTA currently offers full fare Adult Day Passes for \$3.75. A reduced fare Senior/Disabled Day Pass is \$1.75. These Day Passes are currently only available for passengers using Adult or Senior Clipper Cards or RTC Cards. The first ride of the day is charged at full fare. The second ride of the day is charged at a 25 cent discount and triggers the Day Pass feature.

Effective January 1, 2019, Day Passes will also be available for purchase onboard Wheels and Rapid buses. Upon boarding the bus, tell the driver that you want to purchase either an Adult Day Pass (\$3.75) or a Senior/Disabled Day Pass (\$1.75). Insert cash into the farebox. The pass will be printed by the farebox.

For additional rides on the same day, insert the Day Pass into the same slot on the farebox from which it was issued. The pass will be valid for unlimited rides until the last bus goes out of service at approximately 2 am.

## Transfers



Effective January 1, 2019, paper transfers will no longer be issued or accepted as fare payment on Wheels and Rapid buses. Passengers who use multiple Wheels or Rapid routes during the day should use the Day Pass option described to the left, which provides a discount compared to two one-way cash fares.

Passengers who use Clipper Cards for payment will be permitted a single transfer to another Wheels or Rapid bus within 120 minutes of first fare payment. Passengers transferring from BART who have used a Clipper Card for payment on BART will receive a credit towards their Wheels or Rapid fare as follows: Adult (\$1.00); Senior (\$.50); RTC (\$.50); Youth (\$.80). Paper transfers from BART will no longer be accepted. There is no credit for transfers made from Wheels or Rapid buses to BART.

Paper transfers will no longer be accepted as fare payment for passengers transferring from County Connection, WestCat or Tri Delta Transit. Passengers transferring from any of those three East Bay transit operators who use Clipper Cards for payment will be permitted a single transfer to a Wheels or Rapid bus within 120 minutes of first fare payment. The same is true for transfers from Wheels or Rapid buses to County Connection, WestCat or Tri Delta Transit.

***NOTE: All fares and fare policies not referenced in this brochure will not change on January 1, 2019.***

## Senior/Disabled/ Medicare Monthly Pass



Effective January 1, 2019, the price of a discount Senior/Disabled/Medicare monthly pass will be \$22.

## Fare Buster and Senior/Disabled 10-Ride



Effective January 1, 2019, Fare Buster and Senior/Disabled 10-ride tickets will no longer be sold. Fare Buster and Senior/Disabled 10-ride tickets will still be accepted as fare payment through December 31, 2019. Since transfers will no longer be available after January 1, passengers may give the driver two (2) Fare Buster or Senior/Disabled tickets and will be issued a Day Pass.

## Dial-a-Ride Paratransit



Effective January 1, 2019, the fare for a one-way trip on Dial-a-Ride Paratransit will be \$3.75. 10 ride tickets used on Dial-a-Ride Paratransit will continue to be sold and will be priced at \$37.50.

## Youth Fare



Effective January 1, 2019, a new Youth Fare of \$1.60 will be available for passengers 18 years of age and younger who pay using a Youth Clipper Card. Youth Clipper Cards are available at no charge and are available online at [clippercard.com](http://clippercard.com), and in person at the Wheels Administrative Offices and the downtown Livermore Transit Center. The discount Youth Fare is not available with any other form of payment, including cash.
