Fare Policy Changes

Summary of Changes

Effective January 1, 2019, the Livermore Amador Valley Transit Authority (LAVTA) will be implementing a number of fare policy changes. These changes are summarized below.

- **Paper transfers will no longer be issued or accepted**
 - Single transfer still permitted by using Clipper Card
 - Day Pass is best option for multiple trips
- **Day Passes will be available for purchase on Wheels and Rapid Buses**
 - Currently only available on Clipper Card
 - Will be sold on buses at farebox
- **Fare Buster and Senior/Disabled 10-Ride Tickets will no longer be sold**
 - Will still be accepted for payment through December 31, 2019
 - Two (2) 10-Ride Tickets may be used to purchase Day Pass on bus
- **New Youth Clipper Card Fare of \$1.60 will be introduced**
 - Discount only available using Youth Clipper Card
 - Youth Clipper Card is available at no charge at clippercard.com
- **Senior/Disabled/Medicare Monthly Pass price will increase to \$22.00**
- **Dial-a-Ride Paratransit fare will increase will increase to \$3.75**
