

# **Wells School Site Council Meeting Minutes**

**March 7<sup>th</sup>, 2017**

Ean Ainsworth, Lorin Benson, Ashley Courtney, Chandrani Deb, Carson Merrick, Maribel Rouse, Zoe Zannis, Jason Matlon, Rajilazmi Guhagarkar, Dr Leslie Boozer and Merry Dionne were present. The meeting started at 3:33pm.

Ean adjusted and added to Visitations to the Agenda. Merry motioned to approve and Zoe seconded. Motion passed.

Updated To Enrollments And Facilities – Ean said that all students that enrolled after March 1<sup>st</sup> will be diverted to Wells. He estimated we would have between 70 and 100 diversions which would put us at about 1000 students for the 2017-2018 school year. We are adjusting Science Labs to classrooms. This will help with classroom space. Ean said that we are trying to avoid taking teachers classrooms during their prep periods. We are still waiting for allocations from the district office. Zoe asked about how Labs work as classrooms. Carson said that it works and wouldn't be different from a regular classroom. Ean said that lockers are also on the radar.

Visitation For CA Gold Ribbon School and National School Of Character – We will have a validation visit for National School Of Character from Colorado. They are coming March 16<sup>th</sup>. Jason said he has planned Academic Prep already but is waiting for direction from the Validator. On March 23<sup>rd</sup> we will have a validation visit from Alameda County. There will be various panels that will be created that the committee will visit. We might be the only school west of the Mississippi to have both designations. Chandrani asked when we will know if we were selected. Ean said we will know when they leave.

SPSA Review – Ean said that every school has a SPSA. Wells has 3 goals that we would like to try and meet. He said that we have a really good plan and that we mostly meet our goals. He said he would send out the plan in PDF form to everyone so we can look at it. We will visit them in detail at our April meeting. Ean did pass out a handout with the goals on them and briefly addressed each one.

The California Dashboard – Dr. Leslie Boozer had a presentation that explained the elements of the Dashboard. She showed the group how to read it and what it meant to Dublin Unified School District. She wanted input on how to get the information out to the community.

CAASPP – The testing will take place the first two weeks of May. Math will be the first week and English/History will be the second week. We will have a block schedule for the 2 weeks.
