

Wells School Site Council Meeting Minutes

Jere Jones, Ean Ainsworth, Cynthia Arriaga, Lorin Benson, Jason Matlon, Summer Chrisman, Aimee Auer and Merry Dionne were present. The meeting started at 3:35pm.

The Single Plan – Ean said that last year it was rewritten from the ground up. This year there will be minor changes. Some of the Goals will change. Any #'s or demographics will change. The Single Plan is good because we actually do what's in the goals for the most part. There was a survey asking parents for feedback. We had a 10-11% response. The results were similar to the last survey. Ean walked us through the Goals and Action steps that changed. The numbers in the findings will shift because of the data.

CAASPP Results – Ean stated that this was the first year this test was given. Next year we will be able to compare the results from this year. We can tell that we did really well in English. Math compared to the state average was above.

Goal #1 – The word enrichment was changed to elective per the school leadership. We are really focusing on our electives (PLTW, Drama, Band etc.) The Action category is changing to Math Intervention where students with needs will be targeted individually. English is facing the same struggles as Math. We will be adding reading instruction classes for students with low reading levels. We will be targeting the students who won't do the work from the students who are doing the work but need help. ELL will stay the same. Ean is looking forward for Ms. Schrenk to be able to have her schedule adjusted so she can stay longer.

Goal #2 – This year the goal has changed. Teachers will get time to plan and have release days and more collaboration.

Goal #3 – Wells is a positive and Caring School. Some of the conferences like Capturing Kids Hearts has really made a difference. The counselors are having a great impact on the students.

Jason made a motion to revise the Single Plan as presented with some minor changes. Lorin seconded the motion. Everyone was in favor. No one opposed. Motion passed.

Ean will present the new Single Plan to the Board on June 14th. He will ask the Math Dept to attend because of their passion for the new Math Intervention program.
