**NOTICE OF CONSIDERATION OF ADOPTION OF SCHOOL FACILITIES NEEDS ANALYSIS
AND THE ADOPTION OF ALTERNATIVE SCHOOL FEES BY DUBLIN UNIFIED SCHOOL
DISTRICT PURSUANT TO EDUCATION CODE 17620 AND GOVERNMENT CODE SECTIONS
65995.5, 65995.6 AND 65995.7, ADOPTING RESPONSES TO PUBLIC COMMENTS AND MAKING
RELATED FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Trustees of the Dublin Unified School District (“District”) at its regular board meeting to be held on Thursday, June 11, 2020, commencing at 5:30 p.m., will hold a public hearing and consider adoption of a resolution approving a School Facilities Needs Analysis (“SFNA”) and the adoption of Alternative School Fees in compliance with Government Code sections 65995.5, 65995.6 and 65995.7.

Pursuant to Government Code section 65995.6(a), the School District must conduct and adopt an SFNA as one of the prerequisites to levying alternative school facility fees on new residential construction within the School District in excess of those amounts specified in Government Code Section 65995.

The School District adheres as closely as possible to the Orders of the Health Officer of Alameda County. If permitted under those orders, the hearing and meeting may be held in person in the District Board Room (unless otherwise noted), located at 7471 Larkdale Avenue, Dublin, California 94568. **NOTICE OF CONSIDERATION OF APPROVING A CHANGE IN STATUTORY SCHOOL FEES
IMPOSED ON NEW RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL/INDUSTRIAL CONSTRUCTION
PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 65995 AND EDUCATION CODE SECTION
17620**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Trustees of the Dublin Unified School District (“School District”) at its regular board meeting to be held on Thursday, June 11, 2020, commencing at 5:30 p.m., will consider approving a change in the statutory school fees (“Level 1 School Fees”) that may be imposed on new residential and commercial/industrial construction located within the boundaries of the School District pursuant to Government Code section 65995 and Education Code section 17620.

A report entitled “2020 School Fee Justification Study” was prepared pursuant to and in accordance with applicable law, which includes information and analysis demonstrating the relationship between new residential and commercial/industrial development and the School District’s need for the construction of school facilities, the estimated cost of the school facilities, and justification for the levy of Level 1 School Fees on new residential and commercial/industrial development.
