-Elections Code section 10010(b) provides, “In determining the final sequence of the district elections conducted in a political subdivision in which members of the governing body will be elected at different times to provide for staggered terms of office, the governing body shall give special consideration to the purposes of the California Voting Rights Act of 2001... and it shall take into account the preferences expressed by members of the districts.”

-Education Code section 5021(a) provides, “In the event two or more trustee areas are established... which are not represented in the membership of the governing board of the school district...the county committee shall determine by lot the trustee area from which the nomination and election for the next vacancy on the governing board shall be made.”
