Minutes from Thursday, December 5, 2019
3:20 p.m. - Room 3

Meeting called to order at 3:24pm.

1. Approval of [Minutes from 11/7/2019](#): Anne T. motioned to approve, Megan L. seconded.
2. Overview of Intervention Programs at FES with guest speaker Felicia Suminski
 - a. Started Intervention Program 8 years ago, developed to include:
 - i. Universal Screening: STAR Reading (except Kinder which uses classroom data and 1st Grade which uses DRA data. The STAR is optional in 1st grade this year.)
 - ii. Research-based instruction: started with research-based instructional strategies; we now have 2 research-based programs SIPPS (Systematic Instruction in Phonological Awareness, Phonics, and Sight Words) and LLI (Fountas & Pinnell Leveled Literacy Intervention System)
 - iii. Tiers of Intervention: targeted intervention based on data, based on the needs of the students
 - iv. Ongoing monitoring
 - b. Focus is on Language Arts
 - c. Serves 8 groups of students per day, one instructional aide that serves 4 groups per day. Each group is 2-6 students. 30 mins/day, 5 days/week. To date for this school year, we have seen 119 students.
 - d. Mrs. Suminski pushes into one classroom to support 5th Graders.
 - e. In addition, Mrs. Suminski is an ed tech educator and does volunteer clubs and lessons for students in the areas of video-recording, blogging, coding
 - f. Mrs. Suminski runs a yearly parent education night for families.
 - g. Mrs. Suminski has been working with our librarian and ELD Specialist on a Passionate Reader Virtual Book Club reading program where 3rd-5th grade students participate via Google Classroom and receive feedback for Book Club questions.
 - h. SSC members participated in an engaging lesson taught by Mrs. Suminski.
3. Continue the SPSA Review--ELA Goals
 - a. Claire M. reminded the SSC of the SPSA plan timeline and purpose. Timeline for approval has been changed back to the Spring so we will have two SPSA plans created this year. The Spring plan will include revisions of the Fall plan based on our on-going look at data and work throughout the year.
 - b. There are 3 SPSA Goals, ELA, Math, and Social-Emotional Learning:
 - i. ELA: By the end of the school year, 64.8% of all students in 3rd-5th

Grade will obtain Level 3 or Level 4 in ELA on the Spring 2020 CAASPP. 4th and 5th Graders who did not achieve a minimum score for Level 3 will decrease their personal distance from Level 3 on the Spring 2020 CAASPP. 80% of all students in K-2nd are going to meet "end-of-year" grade-level standards in reading.

- ii. SSC members reviewed the grade level goals and the action plan and proposed strategies.
 - c. We will review Math and SEL Goals at our next meeting. JT R. will contact our counselor to see if she can do a presentation in January.
4. PFC Update
- a. Need to find ways to get more parents to come to PFC meetings and volunteer.
 - b. Bingo Night funds raised over \$700. After deducting any facility charges, it will all be donated to Fine Arts program.
 - c. See's fundraiser has been successful, over \$200
 - d. Upcoming Events
 - i. Looking for parent leads for the Family Dance--if not, may need to cancel. Upcoming planned events include:

 - ii. One suggestion is to find a Girl Scout Troop that can lead Family Dance.
5. Open Forum
- a. Coder Dojo is a free coding club in the Tri Valley run by volunteers.
 - b. School Board voted yes on funding Dublin Elementary without shifting money from Frederiksen's modernization.
 - c. Our school's renovations and plans have finalized in DSA. Bids went out and there were many interested companies. December 12th is the due date for the finalized bids. One more community meeting will be held after that.
 - d. JT R. shared her appreciation for all SSC members. She will notify us whether we will keep or skip the January meeting.
