**May 11, Sat., Promotion Dance:** Students MUST have a CURRENT ID card to attend. ID cards can be purchased at the ASB office prior to the dance. Signed permission slips are due no later than Friday, April 19th. "Dress to Impress" is the dress code and Fallon dress and behavior guidelines apply for entry and while at the dance. No backpacks, cameras or cell phones will be allowed in the dance (students/parents alike). Photos may be taken outside on DHS grounds with permission from those being photographed. If your child has been suspended within the last 30 days, s/he is not eligible to attend the dance. Students will be promptly released at 10:00 PM.

**May 29, Wed., Promotion Practice:** All 8th graders are to report to their 1st period class for attendance. Your teacher will walk the class over to the gym for the awards ceremony and promotion practice. 8th graders will be released at 12:30
