

# Kolb PFC Spring 2019 Parent Survey Summary

Kolb PFC surveyed the Kolb Community to learn what events and activities are of most interest. Here are the top ranking items:

## ***Community-building Events***

### **Trunk-or-Treat                      Vote: 68%**

Taking place in the Kolb parking lot during October, Parent Volunteers decorate their vehicles and hand out treats to the kids that stop by to trick-or-treat.

*PFC Budget of \$300. Needs 2 Event Organizers, at least 30 Parent Volunteer Vehicles, and donated candy.*

### **Mornings with Mom                      Vote: 65%**

Kolb students celebrate their mother-figures with breakfast treats at this morning event.

*PFC Budget of \$700. Needs 2 Event Organizers and at least 7 day-of-event volunteers.*

### **Winter Concert                      Vote: 64%**

In coordination with Kolb's Music Teacher, the 4th/5th Grade Choir, with the 3rd Graders on recorder, perform for the Kolb Community at this December evening event.

*PFC Budget of \$200. Needs 1 Event Organizer.*

### **Donuts with Dad                      Vote: 61%**

Kolb students celebrate their father-figures with breakfast treats at this morning event.

*PFC Budget of \$700. Needs 2 Event Organizers and at least 7 day-of-event volunteers.*

### **Art Fair                      Vote: 60%**

Occurring along with Kolb's Spring Open House, the Art Fair highlights pieces created by every student at Kolb through the Art in Action program.

*PFC Budget of \$400. Needs 2 Event Organizers and volunteers to help set up prior to the event.*

### **Family Movie Night                      Vote: 50%**

The Kolb Community gathers together to watch a family-friendly movie in Kolb's MPR.

*PFC Budget of \$1,400. Needs 1 Event Organizer.*

### **Kolb Talent Show                      Vote: 50%**

Kolb students have the opportunity to audition and, if chosen, perform their talent for the Kolb community.

*PFC Budget for custodial fees only. Needs 3 Event Organizers to work alongside Teachers.*

## **Enrichment and Character-building Programs**

### **Art in Action**                      **Vote: 80%**

Parent Volunteers teach 6 art lessons in the classroom throughout the school year.

*PFC Budget of \$7,141. Needs 2 Program Organizers and at least 1 volunteer per classroom.*

### **Science Fair**                      **Vote: 78%**

Interested Kolb students use the scientific method to plan and conduct independent research and present their findings to the Kolb Community at an evening event.

*PFC Budget for poster boards and custodial fees. Needs 1 Event Organizer.*

### **Student Store**                      **Vote: 65%**

Students earn Blue Tickets during the school day by showing positive Character Traits. They then can spend their Blue Tickets at the Student Store on Fridays during recess.

*PFC Budget of \$1,000. Needs 2-3 volunteers every Friday, need not be the same volunteers every time.*

### **Junior Achievement**              **Vote: 59%**

Parent Volunteers teach 5 lessons in the classroom throughout the school year. Lessons cover entrepreneurship, work readiness, and financial literacy through hands-on, experiential activities.

*PFC Budget of \$100. Needs 1 Program Organizer and at least 1 volunteer per classroom.*

### **Breakfast Book Club**              **Vote: 47%**

Occurring one morning a month, interested students come together to read and discuss pre-chosen books.

Participants receive breakfast and keep the books. Participant costs cover the cost of the books.

*PFC Budget of \$7,000. Needs 2 Program Organizers and 6 day-of volunteers to lead separate grade-level book discussions, serve breakfast, and escort students to class. Need not be the same volunteers every time.*

### **Run Club**                      **Vote: 46%**

Every Thursday morning, students can join parents and teachers to burn off some energy before class.

*PFC Budget of \$300. Needs 2 Program Organizers.*

### **Sandia Science Night**              **Vote: 45%**

Sandia's Family Science Night provides an evening of hands-on science activities. Students and parents work together to conduct simple inquiry-based science activities. All materials and instructions are provided.

*PFC Budget for Kolb custodial fees. Needs 1 Event Organizer and 3 volunteers.*

### **Enrichment and Character-building Program ideas proposed by Survey Respondents:**

Sports Day, Mentoring and Peer Tutoring, Math Olympiad, After-School Garden Club, School Recycling Program, STEM Fair/Activities, Craft Fair, Kid powered events (planned and run by kids), additional public speaking opportunities
