Be a Guest Speaker

- Guest speakers typically share about their career path as well as projects that they are working on.
- We welcome all career disciplines to help expose our students to all the possibilities they can pursue within a STEM field.
- Speakers usually select 1 or more classes throughout the day and present to groups of about 30 students at a time for a 40-50 minute block.

Be a Project Evaluator

- We often invite industry partners to come view student projects and provide feedback.
- Project Evaluators will work with teachers to arrange times and dates as well as discuss evaluation tools.

Be a Mentor

- Mentors commit one year to working with one of our Academy Juniors.
- Mentors meet monthly on pre-determined dates to work on topics such as career exploration, resume writing, and interview skills.
- Mentors must complete an application and personal profile to be carefully matched to their student(s).
- Mentors apply online and must attend an orientation to learn all about the program.
