## Fallon Middle School Shade Structure Project



Here we are at the end of another great school year! As you may recall, in 2016 the Interim Housing Project added seven classrooms to the campus to help meet the needs of the increased enrollment at Fallon. During the design process for the project, a lunch shelter canopy was also identified as a high priority need for students at the campus.

In February 2017, the Board of Trustees gave staff direction to move forward with the canopy project. Following the Board's authorization, staff was very busy developing the details of the project. The current scope of work will include the installation of two metal shade structures and site infrastructure. One 30' x 32' lunch shelter will be installed adjacent to the existing lunch shelter located between the gym and Multi-Purpose Room. The second shelter is a 13' x 20' lunch line canopy and will be located northwest of the Multi-Purpose Room and cafeteria serving lines to help students stay out of the weather while waiting for lunch service.

The project is planned to start in summer 2017 and will be completed for the beginning of the 2017/18 school year. Have a great summer break and enjoy the new lunch shelters when you return to Fallon in the fall!
