### Sample Building Design



The Engineering & Science Building Project was approved as part of the Measure E project list in 2013, and the addition of new science labs was approved as part of the Measure H project priority list in 2016. The existing Building EE was identified as the best location for the new Engineering & Science Building. The project will include a new grounds maintenance building near the entrance to the sports fields. The new Engineering & Science Building will replace the current maintenance shop, weight room, and add additional student and staff restrooms, new engineering classrooms/shop space, new flexible science labs, and academic support space. Demolition of Building EE is scheduled for summer 2017. Construction of the Grounds Building Project is planned to start in summer/fall 2017, and construction of the Engineering & Science Building Project is scheduled to begin fall 2018.

### Interim Housing Project

Student enrollment continues to grow in the District and is projected to exceed the current available capacity at Dublin High. A two-phased Interim Housing classroom project has been designed to accommodate projected growth. Phase 1A includes 13 classrooms and support spaces. It is scheduled for completion this summer and ready for the 2017/18 school year. Construction of Phase 1B is planned to start in spring 2018 and will include 12 classrooms and support spaces. Phase 1B is scheduled for completion in summer 2018 if enrollment necessitates.
